# Notice

## **NOTICE TO CAMPERS & CABINS:**

NO DRIVING through Faire Grounds during Faire Time (8:00am—6:30pm on Saturday and 8:00am—4:30pm on Sunday.) If you need to come and go, park in the parking lot. If you're staying on site all weekend without driving your car in and out, you can park next to your campsite or cabin.

- Yellow Dash indicates drivable service road (Walking & Slow Driving 5MPH)
- Yellow Path = Yellow Line Trail (Walking Only)
- Red Path = Red Line Trail (Walking Only)
- Blue Path = Blue Loop Trail (Mixed Use)
- Brown Path = Bog Trail (Walking Only)
- Drive slowly and mindfully if using the Service Road—it doubles as a walking trail. Minimize use—cabin access only.
- The restroom with showers east of the Mess Hall is handicap accessible.
- Please observe quiet hours around cabins and areas where people are camping. Quiet hours are 11PM—6AM
- After-hours social areas include the fire pit, beach, dining hall and pavilion.
- No camping near the beach please.
- If you have any questions or concerns, please visit the Great Lakes Herb Faire booth in the center of the marketplace.
